#### Birds, Trees, and more Bees...

With the Barn Owl perched in the Pavilion on Christmas Eve, attention to birds enjoying the SKC property has increased. Compliments of Jim Yesket and some bird sighting/counting sessions, an ebird report was created for the Siesta Key Chapel property including over 11 species including Woodpeckers, Starlings, Warblers, Robins and Waxwings amongst other types. Jim has also installed an Owl house on a Palm tree near the Chapel in hopes of drawing nesting Screech Owls over the next month or so.

The Post Ian Hurricane Tree cleanup was finally completed with several dead and damaged trees taken down for safety reasons. In addition, Bees found a new home in the Australian Pine as noticed by the Tree Trimmers. The extent of the hive is unknown at this point but preliminary assessments are that it is just starting to form. Beekeepers will be tasked with relocating these bees as well. All in all, the landscape is healthy again and a full canopy cut will be scheduled in 2023 to trim all the Palms. Other things being assessed are improved lighting options for the parking lot areas and walkways as well as erosion control options for the gravel drive entrances on Gleason Ave.
