
tasks. We also continue to get vacationers and those just out for a stroll on the beach who stop to enjoy the service.

## **BUILDINGS, GROUNDS & TECHNOLOGY - Barry Cline**

It's been a very busy Summer for Buildings & Grounds. Some of the Summer projects include:

- 230+ Palm Trees and 8 Grand Oaks Trimmed
- (1) Large Australian Pine in the Back along with
  (3) other Dead trees were removed
- We also have Bees in our Owl Box They are in a good location and not damaging any trees so they'll be our neighbors for a bit.



- We have new Paver Block Aprons on the The Gleason Entrances to the campus we are working on the proper gravel fill for the remaining part of the campus driveway.
- HVAC issues continue to be addressed as the excessive heat created stress on some of the older systems. More of our HVAC systems now have WiFi control and scheduling to assist with Control and and savings in that area.
- Landscape improvements continue with planting and irrigation at the Ocean Blvd Monument Sign. We are working on extending irrigation to additional gardening areas.
- A Lot of effort has been placed on clearing out excessive "stuff" in all the classrooms to assess, improve, and better utilize the spaces we have on campus. Thanks to those that have worked tirelessly on this task.
- All Chapel Sliders were repaired and lubricated. Each Slider now has a deadbolt for ease of locking and improved security.
- Contractors have been contacted and are working on Lighting in the Chapel, Pavilion Ladies Room improvements, Window Cleaning and deck pressure washing.

"The Big Clean" was a productive and well-organized effort to declutter and organize possessions at Siesta Key Chapel. Sorting through items to determine their fate—whether to keep, sell, donate, or discard—was a necessary step in maintaining the chapel's functionality and appearance.

The effort has not only improved the physical environment but also showcased the positive outcomes that collaboration and proactive measures can bring.
